Cyber Hubs pilot – extension

This measure provides funding to extend the Cyber Hubs Pilot which was announced in the 2021-22 Budget.

The Cyber Hub Program will:

- set up a baseline of cyber security monitoring, detection, and protection across government to stop and mitigate threats to government IT systems
- centralise coordination of cyber security through Cyber Hubs to strengthen the Australian Government's cyber resilience
- increase opportunities to focus the Australian Government's cyber security investment
- provide implementation support for cyber services for all government entities, in the future.

Services Australia is one of the government agencies who will provide shared cyber-security services.

The agency will plan and test services for other government agencies to improve their cyber security defences.

Services Australia was allocated \$8 million for 2022-23 in the March 2022-23 budget. This measure allocates an additional \$8 million to this program.

This measure is not subject to the passage of legislation.

Who does this measure affect?

This affects Services Australia and government agencies allocated to the Cyber Hub.

When will this start and finish?

This will start on 1 January 2023 and will end on 30 June 2023.
