


How to avoid an ABSTUDY debt

When a high school student needs to live away from home



Things could change in your life. This can affect how much ABSTUDY we can pay you.

It's important you tell us within 14 days if something changes for you or your child. If you don't tell us, we may pay you too much ABSTUDY. This means you'll get a debt which you'll need to pay back.



What to tell us about

You need to tell us if any of these things happen:

- your child changes schools
- your child can't go to school for some reason
- your child stops studying away from home
- your child starts living with another parent or guardian
- you move house or towns
- you start or stop jobs or your income changes
- your child aged 16 or older starts earning money
- you start a new relationship or separate from your partner.




How to tell us
