Periods of employment are periods where you worked while living in Australia as an Australian resident.

Employment or self-employment means paid employment, it does not mean voluntary or community work.

Note: If you are claiming an invalid pension from the United States, you need to provide details of at least 5 years employment, or self-employment, out of the last 10 years prior to your disability onset date.

You must provide any original documents that we can use to confirm your periods of employment or self-employment in Australia. If you live in Australia, take these documents to your local Services Australia office. If you live outside Australia, take these documents to any office of the social security authorities in the country in which you live. The documents will be copied and returned to you.

Suitable documents include:

- · payment summaries
- tax returns
- Superannuation Guarantee records
- statements from employer showing periods of employment
- · union records
- · training certificates
- any original documents that verify employment or self-employment in Australia.

An affidavit or a statement from you stating employment or self-employment details is not sufficient as verification.

If you do not provide suitable documents, Services Australia may not be able to verify the details you have given and your claim may be rejected.
