Claim for Special Employment Advance

When to use this form



Use this form to claim a Special Employment Advance. A Special Employment Advance can help if you are:

- offered a job but you do not have enough money to pay for something you need to start your job
- short of money because you (or your partner) have worked but have not yet been paid and the earnings have reduced your Centrelink payment by at least 50%.

You must repay a Special Employment Advance to us. The advance can be between \$50 and \$500. The amount you get will depend on your circumstances.

Who can apply for a Special Employment Advance?

You can apply if you get one of the following payments:

- · Austudy Payment
- Carer Payment
- Disability Support Pension
- JobSeeker Payment
- Parenting Payment (Single)
- Youth Allowance

Repaying a Special Employment Advance

If you continue to get a payment from us, we will deduct a fortnightly amount from it, until you have paid the advance back.

If you stop getting a payment from us, you still need to repay the amount you owe us. We will send you an account and tell you how to do this.

Online account



Many of our customers find it easier to claim payments and manage their details using their Centrelink online account or Express Plus Centrelink mobile app.

You need a myGov account to link and use your Centrelink online account or Express Plus Centrelink mobile app. If you do not have a myGov account, go to **my.gov.au** and create one. For help, go to **servicesaustralia.gov.au/onlineguides**

What else you may need to provide

Important note: You must return **all** supporting documents at the same time you lodge this claim form. If you do not return all documents, your claim may not be accepted. The only exception will be if you are waiting for documents from a third party.
