

Healthcare Identifiers Service Application to deactivate, reactivate or retire a healthcare organisation (HW044)

When to use this form

Use this form to deactivate, reactivate or retire a Healthcare Provider Identifier Organisation (HPI-O) record within the Healthcare Identifiers (HI) Service.

Healthcare Identifiers Service

The HI Service provides a consistent set of identifiers for healthcare individuals and healthcare providers (organisations and individuals). The HI Service enables providers to associate health information about a healthcare individual in a consistent and accurate manner. The association of identifiers can be used within electronic communications such as discharge summaries, prescriptions and referrals.

Deactivate

An organisation record may be deactivated when a seed organisation or network organisation registered in the HI Service temporarily ceases to operate as a legal business entity. An organisation may also elect to no longer participate in the HI Service. Upon deactivation, the HPI-O record and the National Authentication Services for Health (NASH) Public Key Infrastructure (PKI) certificate cannot be used in an operational context within the HI Service. Access to the Healthcare Provider Directory (HPD) and the My Health Record system will be removed.

Reactivate

An organisation record may be reactivated when a previously deactivated seed organisation or network organisation wishes to participate again in the HI Service. The originally allocated HPI-O will be retained for the reactivated organisation. The HI Service will enable HI Service permissions for the NASH PKI certificate for the reactivated HPI-O.

Retire

An organisation record may be retired when a seed organisation or network organisation registered in the HI Service, permanently ceases to operate as a business entity. This means the organisation will no longer be active in the HI Service and will be unable to undertake HI Service related activities via this record.

The HPI-O record and NASH PKI certificate cannot be used within the HI Service and access to the Healthcare Provider Directory and the My Health Record system will be removed. An organisation that has been retired cannot be reactivated.

Important information

When any of the above statuses are applied to a seed organisation, the status will also be automatically applied to all associated network organisations registered under the organisational hierarchy. If a seed organisation is being updated, the applicant can only be the responsible officer (RO) for the organisation. If a network organisation is being updated, the applicant can be an organisation maintenance officer (OMO) for the organisation.

Health Professional Online Services

Healthcare providers can do online business with Services Australia through Health Professional Online Services (HPOS), including selected HI Service functions. You will need a Provider Digital Access (PRODA) account, and then link your services.

Healthcare Provider Directory

The HPD is a directory of healthcare identifiers and business details for providers and organisations registered in the HI Service. Only individuals or organisations that are authorised can search the HPD for details. You can use these details to link a provider to your organisation for My Health Record system access, or to find out contact details for referrals and other services. Your organisation automatically gets an entry in the HPD, and you can update details at any time through HPOS.
