Unte Parenting Payment Single inetyeke:

- unte single anetyeke
- unte ampe akweke atnyenetyeke
- unte ampe or ampe mape atnyenetyeke.

Unte change irretyeke Parenting Payment Single werne, payments arrpenhe nhenhe atherreengetyele JobSeeker or Youth Allowance unte apeke ampe mape arntarnte areme.

Unte Parenting Payment Single inetyenhenge ampe ngkwinhe 14 years old turn irrerlenge.

Unte claim mpwareme Parenting Payment Single-eke, unte information anwerne anthetyeke:

- Tax File Number (TFN) anthetyeke
- unte warrke atnyeneme, anwerne payslip anthetyeke anwerne-le mane arratye payemeletyenhenge.

Unte anwerne-ke angketyeke Child Support-akerte.

Unte parenting mane renhe ineme, unte report-emeletyeke changes Centrelink werne 14 days-enge:

- mane apeke unte ineme warrke-engtyele
- mane arrpenhe-engetyele ineme
- partner arrpenhe inerlenge or ampe mape kenhe meye or akngeye-enge
- life ngkwinhe apeke change irrerlenge.

Nhenhe ring-emelaye report-emeletyeke Indigenous Call Centre or Centrelink app-ngkwinhe useemeletyeke.

Unte report-emeletyeke unte debt ineme-ketyenge ante mane pay-eme back ileme.

Unte debt akerte, anwerne ngenhe help-emeleme pay-eme back iletyeke.

Unte ahentye aneme information awetheke:

- local Services Australia (Centrelink) service centre ngkwinhe aretyeke
- angketyeke Services Australia (Centrelink) itne ilengare community ngkwinhe werne alheme
- ring-emelaye Indigenous Call Centre werne 1800 136 380-enge.

Unte anwerne ring-emeleme, unte anwerne-ke iletyeke Customer Reference Number (CRN) ngkwinhe ante questions mape answer-emeletyeke, anwerne akaltye anetyenhenge unte kwenhe yanhe aneme.

Unte arlke layaketyeke interpreter-ke unte apeke ring-emeleme or aretyeke apeke. Anwerne anyente inetyenhenge free ngwenge.



Parenting Payment Single

You can get Parenting Payment Single if:

- you are single
- you have just had a baby
- you have a kid or kids that you look after.

You can change over to Parenting Payment Single from other payments like JobSeeker or Youth Allowance when you have a baby or start looking after a kid.

You can get Parenting Payment Single until your youngest kid turns 14 years old.

When you claim Parenting Payment Single, we need information from you like:

- your Tax File Number (TFN)
- if you have job, we need payslips so we pay you the right money.

You will also need to talk to us about Child Support.

When you start getting parenting money, you need to report to Centrelink within 14 days if you:

- get money from a job
- get any other money
- get a new partner or get back with the kids' mother or father
- have any changes in your life.

You can report by calling the Indigenous Call Centre or using your Centrelink app.

You need to report so you do not get a debt and have to pay it back.

If you have a debt, we can help make a plan to pay it back.

If you need more information you can:

- visit your local Services Australia (Centrelink) service centre
- talk to Services Australia (Centrelink) when they visit your community
- call the Indigenous Call Centre on 1800 136 380.

If you call us, you need to tell us your Customer Reference Number (CRN) and answer some questions about who you are, so that we make sure it is you.

You can also ask for an interpreter when you call or visit us. We will provide one for free.
