



## Family Tax Benefit akerte

Unte Family Tax Benefit (FTB) inetyeke unte apeke:

- ampe akweke new one atnyeneke
- ampe akweke mape akerte care ngkwinhenge
- ampe high school-enge or approved study-enge itne Centrelink payment inetyekenhe.

Unte FTB inetyeke unte ampe arntarnte areme ampe nyente or ampe atningke ampe ngkwinhe mape anetyekenhe. Ampe nhenhe mape family ngkwinhe mape kenhe apeke or itne aneme ngkwenge or unte kinship carer aneme.

Unte ampe akweke atnyeneme, unte FTB claim start-emeletyeye ready anetyenhenge 3 months ampe ngkwinhe arenhe interlenghe. Nhenhe itne ileme pre-birth FTB claim.

Unte FTB claim-emeleme unte anwerne anthetyeke:

- Tax File Number (TFN) ngkwinhe anthetyeke ante unte partner atnyeneme, anwerne anthetyeke TFN ikwerenhe
- Customer Reference Number (CRN) ngwhinhe-ke
- paper imernetyeke unte carer aneme ampe anyenteke or ampe mapeke claim-emelemele itne-ke.

Unte apeke TFN-ke arrangkwe, unte apply irretyeye anyente-ke local service centre werne alhemele or angketyeke Services Australia (Centrelink) itne community ngkwinhe werne alhelenge.

Unte start irretyeye pre-birth FTB claim ngkwinhe, anwerne paper anthetyenhenge hospital unte ampe new one renhe atnyenelenge. Anwerne paper ngkwinhe-ke ahentye anwerne finish-emeletyenhenge pre-birth FTB claim ngkwinhe ante ampe new one ngkwinhe Medicare card ngkwinhenge irrernetyeke.

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## Family Tax Benefit

You can get the Family Tax Benefit (FTB) if you:

- have a new baby
- have young kids in your care
- have kids in high school or approved study who are not getting a Centrelink payment.

You may also be able to get FTB if you are caring for a kid or kids that are not yours. This could be a kid or kids from your family who lives with you or you may be a kinship carer.

If you are going to have a baby, you can also start to get your FTB claim ready 3 months before your baby is born. This is called a pre-birth FTB claim.

When claiming FTB you need to give us:

- your Tax File Number (TFN) and if you have a partner, we need their TFN
- your Customer Reference Number (CRN)
- papers that show you are the carer for the kid or kids you are claiming for.

If you do not have a TFN, you can apply for one by visiting your local service centre or talking to Services Australia (Centrelink) when they visit your community.

If you have started your pre-birth FTB claim, we need the papers the hospital gives you after you have a new baby. We need these papers so we can finish your pre-birth FTB claim and also add your new baby to your Medicare card.

### If you need more information you can:

- visit your local Services Australia (Centrelink) service centre
- talk to Services Australia (Centrelink) when they visit your community
- call the Indigenous Call Centre on 1800 136 380.

If you call us, you will need to tell us your Customer Reference Number (CRN) and answer some questions about who you are, so that we make sure it is you.

You can also ask for an interpreter when you call or visit us. We will provide one for free.
